Robert M. Califf Award for Outstanding Mentorship

Each fellow who spends time at the DCRI has a mentor whose responsibility it is to guide the fellow in all things: an introduction to the DCRI; academics, including statistical principles and manuscript writing; clinical research, often including hotline duty; career development; and clinical work with one or more faculty members when they see patients. Mentors are critical to the success of the fellows, and, beginning in 2006, mentor(s) are honored each year with the Robert M. Califf Award for Outstanding Mentorship.

This award is designed to recognize a DCRI faculty member who has demonstrated excellence in mentorship activities for DCRI research fellows. Faculty members considered for this award are expected to have mentored fellows at the DCRI and to have demonstrated enthusiasm and commitment towards the training of fellows in clinical research activities at the DCRI.
