We seek committed clinical investigators, who are team players eager to split their professional effort between clinical nephrology and clinical research leadership and mentorship. We define clinical research broadly to include epidemiology, outcomes research, population health, patient-oriented research, and all aspects of interventional studies, including all phases of clinical trials, pragmatic trials, and data coordinating center management. Ideal applicants will have strong clinical skills, a track record of original research scholarship, and passion for conducting cutting-edge multisite human research. Successful candidates will grow their externally funded research program at Duke while providing vision and strategic direction for clinical research activities within the Division and in nephrology research at the DCRI. All Duke faculty are expected to contribute to our educational mission, including supervision and teaching of Duke students, residents and fellows in the course of clinical attending. There will be ample opportunities for research mentorship of trainees at all stages.
